



## **Kansas Search & Rescue Response System General Training Requirements**

Each member shall:

- Complete a new member orientation to include an overview of the regional, state, and federal US&R organizational structures and response systems
- Complete Critical Incident Stress awareness training
- Complete the IS-100, IS-200, IS-700 and IS-800B online training courses
- Complete blood-borne pathogen training in accordance with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1030
- Complete training at the First Responder Operations Level for Hazardous Materials (OSHA 29 CFR, 1910.120)
  - Complete annual refresher training as required for the First Responder Operations Level for Hazardous Materials (OSHA 29 CFR, 1910.120)
- Complete the National US&R WMD Enhanced Operations course or equivalent
- Be certified in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (members currently licensed or certified as EMT (all levels) and licensed board certified emergency physicians inherently meet this requirement)
- Complete respiratory protection training per OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134 (k)
  - Complete refresher training as required for respiratory protection training per OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134 (k)
    - Have successfully completed an annual quantitative respiratory protection fit test required per 29 CFR 1910.134 App. A
- Complete NFPA 1670 Awareness Level training for:
  - Confined space rescue operations
  - Water rescue operations
  - Structural collapse rescue operations
