*For Kansans who are deaf or hard-of-hearing, we offer FREE alarm devices with loud sounds, flashing lights and vibrations.*

**To qualify for the program you must...**

- A. Be a Kansas resident over the age of four.
- B. Have a listed certifying health care professional sign your order form.
- C. NOT live in an institutional facility (nursing home, hospital, etc.)



Once approved by our office, the alarm will be delivered and installed by a participating fire department or KSFM representative who can ensure the alarm is set-up properly and you know how it works.
