




# Oxygen Firebreak

From 2017-2021, home medical oxygen was involved in an average of 1,041 thermal burns annually.<sup>[3]</sup>



- From 2017-2021, U.S. fire departments responded to an estimated 228 home fires per year involving oxygen equipment.<sup>[3]</sup>
- An estimated 96 people per year died in those fires.<sup>[3]</sup>
- From 2017-2021 people aged 60-69 are more likely to be injured by medical oxygen related burns in the ER.<sup>[3]</sup>
- Smoking materials account for 59% of medical oxygen related burns in the ER.<sup>[3]</sup>
