



Oxygen Firebreak

Every year in the U.S. there are over 228 home fires involving home oxygen therapy equipment.^[3]



- More than 70 deaths and emergency departments treat over 1,000 people for burns annually.^[3]
- Thermal fuses don't stop the fire from starting, but can stop it from spreading.
- Oxygen is one of three things needed for a fire to start and keep going.
- 2 thermal fuses should be used, one close to the face where nasal tubes are located and one near the oxygen outlet.
