



Q: Do we have to do Monthly Fire Drills along with the 9 Drills Required by this new bill?

A: No, the 9 drills that is outlined in the bill is taking the place for the Monthly Fire Drill Requirement.

Q: Do the crisis drills have to include the whole school or can it just affect one section of the school?

A: The crisis drill must affect the whole school for it to be considered toward one of the four crisis drills.

Q: Is there a new form to go along with the new requirements?

A: Yes, the form has been updated at all places on our website.

Q: Can we do extra fire drills or tornado drills to help make up the 4 crisis drills.

A: No, the bill states 4 fire drills and 2 tornado drills. That means the remaining 3 crisis drills need to be something different.

Q: Do preschools have to do the 9 drills now as well?

A: We believe the changes proposed in SB 128 would apply to all programs that qualify as educational occupancies, even if they are not co-located within a school.

Q: Can we do multiple Crisis Drills on the same day?

A: No, these are to be done throughout the whole school year.

Q: What types of crisis drills should be completed.

A: The bill focused on active shooter and lockdown drills. Past that you can conduct drills that would be a potential crisis for your school specifically.

Q: Can School Bus evacuation drills count towards one of the nine crisis drills required?

A: No, the crisis drills need to be building specific crisis drills.
